3 (3+0)	Studies in Second Language Teaching and Learning	601

3 (3+0)	Oriented Studies in Sociolinguistics	620
This course introduces Arab and foreign libraries to the field of sociolinguistics and sociolinguistics, particularly those related to the relationship between society and second language acquisition, linguistic diversity, language policy, and the relationship between structure, function, concept, language, and age, in addition to studies and research that address the social and cultural context of second language learning.

It also covers selecting the sample, its types and description, the types of research tools and how to apply them, analyzing research data, and concluding with the research outcomes.
